An 18th-century English oak low side table of refined yet understated form, raised on elegant cabriole legs terminating in simple pad feet. The proportions are compact and practical, measuring 24 inches wide and 24 inches high, making it especially versatile for use as a low side table, lamp table, or occasional table.

The rectangular top is framed with a molded edge and retains a warm, time-softened patina. The surface shows honest wear, light undulation, and small marks consistent with age, reinforcing its authenticity rather than detracting from it. The apron features a gently shaped arch to each side, adding a subtle decorative movement that complements the curvature of the legs.

The cabriole legs are well drawn and proportioned, displaying the restrained elegance associated with mid-18th-century English country furniture. The oak has developed a rich, mellow tone over time, with visible grain patterning and natural variation throughout.

Its modest scale makes it adaptable in a range of interiors — beside a chair, between windows, or as a low occasional table in a layered traditional setting.
