18TH CENTURY FRENCH PROVINCIAL WALNUT DINING TABLE WITH SCALLOPED APRON

An 18th-century French walnut dining table of generous scale, retaining a warm honey-toned patina and beautifully figured plank top. The surface is composed of a single plank framed within wide boards, showcasing natural movement, knots, and age lines consistent with period provincial craftsmanship.

The apron is carved with a continuous scalloped silhouette, adding subtle decorative rhythm without excessive ornament. The table stands on four elegant cabriole legs that taper gently and terminate in understated feet, giving the piece a balanced, refined presence while remaining rustic in character.

A single side drawer is integrated into the apron, maintaining functionality without interrupting the overall line.

The proportions are excellent for modern use:

76.5"W x 39"D x 30"H

Apron to floor: 24.5"H, allowing comfortable seating clearance.

The table works beautifully as:

A dining table seating 6 comfortably

A large writing or library table

A kitchen farmhouse centerpiece

The color and surface have depth without heaviness — very usable in both traditional and transitional interiors.
