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18TH CENTURY SPANISH WALNUT LOW TABLE WITH ANGLED LEGS

This Spanish walnut table dates to the 18th century and reflects the direct, utilitarian character of vernacular Iberian furniture. Constructed from thick walnut planks, the table features a rectangular top formed from wide boards showing pronounced grain, shrinkage, and surface wear consistent with age and long use. The top retains a warm, well-developed patina with visible marks that speak to its working history rather than later refinement.

The table stands on four boldly angled legs tenoned directly into the frame, a construction method typical of Spanish provincial furniture and valued for its strength and durability. The low stance and generous apron height indicate a piece intended for informal domestic use—functioning as a low table, work surface, or occasional table—rather than a formal dining table. The form prioritizes stability and material honesty over symmetry or ornament.

The underside reveals straightforward joinery and thick framing, reinforcing its vernacular origins. The proportions, while unconventional by modern standards, are entirely consistent with Spanish rural furniture of the 18th century, where function dictated form.

Strong in presence yet restrained in design, this table integrates easily into both traditional interiors and more contemporary spaces that value authenticity, raw materiality, and historic craftsmanship.
