A solid 19th-century French fruitwood dining table with a classic provincial character and a practical extension system. The proportions are straightforward and honest: a 62-inch top built from thick fruitwood planks, resting on twin trestle-style supports joined by a long stretcher for stability. The fruitwood has the expected warmth, soft sheen, and naturally varied grain that only a century of use produces. Two original leaves, each 17 inches, slot cleanly into place to bring the table to full length, making it suitable for a kitchen, dining room, or informal gathering space.

The apron and base retain their early joinery, visible from below and wear consistent with authentic 19th-century rural French furniture. The footed base is wide and steady, giving the piece a grounded presence without heaviness. The top shows the expected age-related undulations and color shifts but remains structurally sound and visually coherent.

In use, it's the kind of table that anchors a room—long, honest, and built for daily life. Its extensions make it adaptable for both everyday meals and larger gatherings, while the fruitwood finish brings genuine warmth to any interior.
