This 19th-century French trumeau mirror features a hand-painted oil on canvas panel depicting a lively hunting scene set within a softly rendered landscape. The composition centers on a hunter in period attire aiming his rifle, accompanied by dogs in pursuit, while additional figures animate the background across a gently rolling terrain. The scene is executed in a naïve yet engaging manner, with a focus on narrative clarity and movement rather than strict academic precision, characteristic of decorative overmantel paintings of the period.

The painting is set within a molded giltwood frame adorned with cast and applied ornament, displaying foliate and scroll motifs at the corners and intersections. Below, a mirror plate completes the composition, creating the classic vertical division associated with French trumeaux, originally designed to be placed above a fireplace or console.

The reverse reveals traditional construction, along with a stamped mark reading “R. Doublé, 1009 des Ayres 24, Bordeaux,” indicating a regional maker or supplier and reinforcing the French origin. The proportions and decorative presence make this piece particularly well-suited for adding vertical emphasis and historical character to an interior.
