A charming French faux bamboo mirror dating to circa 1900, with a warm wood frame composed of turned elements designed to imitate the segmented form of natural bamboo. The slender rails are joined by boldly turned corner posts that extend beyond the frame, giving the mirror its distinctive architectural silhouette and a pleasing sense of rhythm.

Faux bamboo furniture and decorative objects became fashionable in Europe during the late 19th century, reflecting the period's fascination with Asian design and naturalistic forms. Here, the style is interpreted in turned wood, with subtle variations in tone and a mellow patina that lend warmth and depth to the frame.

Compact and highly decorative, this antique mirror would work beautifully above a small console, chest of drawers, or washstand, and is equally suited to a powder room, guest room, or layered gallery wall. Its restrained scale makes it especially useful in smaller spaces, while the sculptural frame gives it considerably more presence than its dimensions might suggest.
