A circa 1900 faux bamboo rectangular mirror with a warm honey-toned wood frame, molded bamboo-style rails, and distinctive decorative corner finials. The frame is constructed with rounded faux bamboo members joined at the corners, with notched and angled end details that give the mirror a more architectural silhouette than a standard rectangular frame.

The mirror has a narrow profile and useful medium scale, making it well suited for an entryway, powder room, bedroom, dressing area, or grouped with other antique and vintage mirrors. The faux bamboo form gives it a decorative character associated with late 19th- and early 20th-century taste, while the warm finish makes it easy to place in both traditional and more relaxed interiors.

The frame shows attractive age, with visible surface wear, small marks, finish variation, and patina throughout. The mirror plate shows age-related spotting and wear, adding to the antique character of the piece. The back retains an older wood panel with later hanging wire.
