ENGLISH 1800S GILTWOOD CONSOLE TABLE WITH MAHOGANY TOP AND VITRUVIAN SCROLLS

An English giltwood console table from the early 19th century with mahogany veneered top, brass banding, Vitruvian scroll motifs, cabriole legs and acanthus leaves. Created in England during the early years of the 19th century, this console table attracts our immediate attention with its giltwood structure supporting a mahogany veneered top with brass banding. The apron is adorned with a large Vitruvian scroll frieze with campanulas under petite beads running along the three sides while the back is unfinished. The table will indeed look best placed against a wall. The ensemble is raised on large cabriole legs accented with acanthus leaf motifs, angled in the front and flat in the back. Mounted on petite feet, this English giltwood and mahogany top console table circa 1800 will make a statement in any home, perhaps placed in a living room or foyer, supporting a vase, a pair of candlesticks or a pair of table lamps.
