This lid opens up to reveal a green felt covered interior with signs of aging. The sides are flanked with lateral brass Chippendale style handles allowing the piece to be moved more easily, while the back is accented with snap buttons. The façade presents a simple leather handle. The piece is raised on four petite patinated brass ball feet completing the ensemble beautifully. With its nicely distressed patina, age and history, this English leather case from the 19th century will bring a touch of authenticity to any home!
