ENGLISH 19TH CENTURY MAHOGANY BUTLER'S TRAY TABLE WITH SHAPED BRACKETS

A refined 19th century English mahogany butler's tray table, combining practical design with restrained architectural detailing.

The tray features shaped, pierced handholds on all four sides, with gently scalloped edges that soften the rectangular form. The warm mahogany displays a well-developed patina, with natural tonal variation and surface character consistent with age. The tray rests on a fixed stand with clean, square legs and subtle molded rails. Each corner is strengthened visually and structurally by small shaped brackets, lending a late Georgian influence to the silhouette. The proportions are compact and balanced, standing just under 20 inches high, making it versatile as a tea table, side table, or occasional serving piece.

The form reflects the enduring practicality of English tray tables of the 19th century — designed for service yet elegant enough for drawing room use. The tray adds functionality while preserving the clean lines of the base.
