This English mahogany Pembroke table from the 19th century is a refined example of functional elegance. The form makes it particularly adaptable, serving equally well as a side table, occasional table, or small writing desk.

A single drawer is set into the apron, retaining its original brass ring pulls and centered with an escutcheon, adding both utility and decorative detail. The table is supported on four slender, tapering legs, each fitted with brass casters that provide ease of movement while underscoring the lightness of the design. The clean, balanced proportions reflect the late Georgian and Regency influence, offering a timeless silhouette that suits both traditional and more contemporary interiors.

The combination of versatility, graceful lines, and quality mahogany construction ensures this Pembroke table remains as practical today as when it was first crafted, an enduring piece of English 19th-century furniture with understated sophistication.
