This English 19th century serving tray is crafted in solid oak and features a handsome octagonal form measuring 22.5 inches wide by 13.5 inches deep with a 2 inch height. The warm oak surface is centered by an oval marquetry medallion composed of radiating veneers, with matching inlaid corner panels that add refinement and visual rhythm to the top.

The tray is fitted with a silvered metal gallery rail, supported by turned posts and capped finials, giving it a restrained yet architectural profile. The contrasting dark wood handles are comfortably shaped and mounted within the gallery frame, offering both functionality and visual balance.

The combination of oak, marquetry detailing, and metal gallery reflects the practical elegance typical of late Victorian English household pieces. It works equally well as a serving tray, bar tray, or decorative accent on a console or ottoman.

The underside reveals solid oak construction with visible fastenings consistent with period manufacture.
