A shaped stretcher reinforces the lower frame, echoing the scalloped apron with decorative continuity.

The oak has acquired a rich, time-softened patina, showcasing centuries of wear and polish. The bench offers a generous 20-inch seat height, making it well-suited for use in an entryway, hallway, or under a bank of windows. With its noble silhouette and enduring craftsmanship, this English bench adds historic character and rustic charm to traditional interiors.
