This English iron table from circa 1900 features a striking tripod base with pronounced scrolled ironwork and distinctive cannonball feet, topped with a round white marble slab. The design is both sculptural and practical, combining the visual weight of hand-forged iron with the brightness and utility of stone. Its silhouette is unusually strong, with the outward sweep of the legs and curled central detail giving the piece a bold decorative presence from every angle.

The cannonball feet are what set it apart. They give the base a grounded, almost whimsical quality, while the scrolling iron introduces movement and keeps the form from feeling heavy. The marble top provides a crisp contrast to the darker metal and makes the table easy to place in a range of interiors, from garden room or conservatory settings to more traditional living spaces. It could serve well as a center table, breakfast table, drinks table, or occasional table.

The iron has a weathered patina that suits the form, and the marble appears to be a later replacement. Overall, it is a handsome and characterful English table with real decorative impact.
