These doors are each made of a simple recessed panel and open thanks to a brass pull and iron hinges to reveal a distressed interior presenting each an upper shelf. The doors are visually separated from one another on the façade through a recessed panel located in the center. The sides are recessed and the back is, of course, unfinished. Raised on very short feet, this English Georgian period elm buffet from the 18th century will bring a touch of rustic elegance to any home, placed in a dining room or living room.
