A handsome English oak bucket from the 19th century, bound with two wide bands of patinated brass and fitted with pierced brass lugs for lifting or hanging. The warm, polished oak staves display attractive vertical grain and a deepened tone from age and use, while the brass has developed a naturally mottled finish that adds to the piece's period charm.

The bucket stands 12 inches high and measures 15 inches wide at the lugs, with an inner depth of 11.75 inches. The proportions and sturdy construction suggest it originally served a practical purpose—possibly for water, coal, or kitchen use—yet it reads today as a refined decorative object. The darkened interior and wear on the base are consistent with functional 19th-century craftsmanship.

This versatile piece would work equally well beside a fireplace, as a planter, or simply as a sculptural accent in a traditional or rustic interior. Its timeless form and honest materials evoke the quiet utility and enduring appeal of English country house furnishings.
