ENGLISH OAK DROP-LEAF GATELEG TABLE WITH TURNED LEGS AND STRETCHERS, CIRCA 1900

This English oak drop-leaf gateleg table, dating to circa 1900, features a compact and versatile form supported by turned legs and stretchers in the traditional English manner. The round top is composed of solid oak boards with a warm, medium-brown patina and lively grain. Two drop leaves extend outward to create a generous circular surface when open, while folding neatly down to form a narrow profile when closed.

The gateleg mechanism is supported by turned legs joined by stretchers and resting on shaped, block feet, providing stability and visual weight. The turned elements lend a classic country character, consistent with late Victorian and early Edwardian oak furniture.

Fully opened, the table measures 25.75 inches wide by 24 inches deep and 20.5 inches high. When closed, it narrows to just 9.25 inches in width, making it ideal for smaller spaces. The leaves measure approximately 8.75 inches each.

Its modest height makes it particularly suitable as a side table, lamp table, or occasional table rather than a dining-height example. The proportions and straightforward construction reflect English country craftsmanship of the period.
