An English oak drop-leaf gateleg table dating to circa 1900, crafted in solid oak with a rich, time-softened surface. Compact when closed and generously proportioned when open, the table offers flexibility without sacrificing substance.

The oval top is formed of solid oak boards with visible grain movement and honest age-related character. When the leaves are raised, the table opens to 30 inches in width, creating a practical surface for dining, tea service, or display. Closed, it measures just 11.25 inches wide, allowing it to function neatly against a wall or in narrower spaces.

The base features turned baluster legs joined by stretchers and supported by classic gateleg construction. The feet are robust and slightly scrolled, giving the piece a grounded, architectural quality typical of English country furniture from the turn of the 20th century. The warm brown finish highlights the natural figuring of the oak and reinforces its restrained, traditional character.

A versatile and well-scaled example suitable for a breakfast room, library, or flexible entertaining space.
