ENGLISH REGENCY WINGBACK ARMCHAIR ON CASTERS, CIRCA 1820

This English wingback armchair dates to the Regency period, circa 1820, and exemplifies the generous proportions and enveloping comfort characteristic of early 19th-century English seating. The tall, gently flared wingback rises above a deep seat and padded arms, creating a chair intended for warmth, repose, and long periods of sitting.

The chair is raised on tapered mahogany legs, terminating in original brass cup casters, allowing for easy movement while reinforcing its domestic function within a drawing room or library. The stance is elegant yet grounded, with slightly splayed rear legs and a confident, upright posture typical of the period.

Upholstered in a light-colored patterned fabric with floral and foliate motifs, the chair presents a soft, traditional appearance that complements both classic and layered interiors. The upholstery appears later, as expected, and serves to highlight the sculptural lines of the Regency frame rather than distract from them.

Well suited for use as an accent chair, reading chair, or fireside seat, this piece offers both visual presence and comfort. It is a strong example of English Regency seating, combining refined form with practical domestic design.
