The lower section showcases the buffet part made of two drawers sitting above two doors adorned with recessed burl panels and arching motifs. The drawers are fitted with brass bail handles on floral backplates, flanking a shield-shaped escutcheon while the doors present sinuous hardware with etched accents. The apron is scalloped on three sides. Showcasing a peg construction, the vaisselier is mounted on one petite foot. The sides are made of recessed panels while the back is unfinished. With its elegant lines and great wood grain, this French elm vaisselier from the 19th century will make for a wonderful addition to any dining room!
