A French gilt faux bamboo mirror from circa 1900, featuring a sculptural frame with turned bamboo-style rails, raised nodes, and distinctive angled corner terminals. The gilt finish has a warm, time-softened tone with areas of rubbing, age-darkening, and surface variation that give the piece an attractive antique character without feeling overly formal.

The square mirror plate is set within a lively architectural frame whose projecting corner elements add movement and a slightly whimsical quality. The faux bamboo motif was especially popular in France around the turn of the 20th century, often associated with Japonisme, garden rooms, dressing areas, and decorative interiors with a light exotic influence.

Its compact scale makes it easy to place above a small chest, in a powder room, hallway, bedroom, or layered into a gallery wall. The back shows an older board and hanging wire. A charming decorative mirror with strong form, warm gilding, and useful proportions.
