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FRENCH EMPIRE WALNUT COMMODOE WITH EBONIZED COLUMNS, EARLY 19TH CENTURY

This French Empire walnut commode presents the clean architectural lines and restrained ornamentation associated with the early 19th century. Its façade is arranged in the classic Empire rhythm: a long upper drawer above three full-width drawers, each set with round brass pulls that punctuate the warm, highly figured walnut. The vertical ebonized columns at the front corners are signature elements of the period, their simplified bases and capitals echoing ancient prototypes while giving the chest a strong structural presence. The walnut surfaces show a rich grain pattern that reads clearly across the drawer fronts and sides, giving the piece a unified, elegant profile.

Inside, the dovetailed drawers reflect solid craftsmanship, and the commode's overall proportions make it versatile for a bedroom, entry, or living space. The back and underside retain their traditional construction, indicating its 19th-century origin. This is a refined example of Empire furniture in walnut—less common than mahogany—offering warmth, clarity, and period character without excessive ornamentation.
