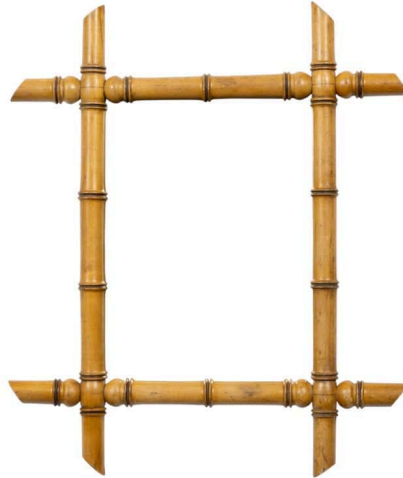




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FRENCH FAUX BAMBOO CARVED WOOD WALL MIRROR, CIRCA 1900

This charming French faux bamboo wall mirror, crafted around 1900, captures the enduring appeal of one of the most recognizable decorative styles of the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. Carved in wood to imitate natural bamboo, the frame features segmented "cane" details, rounded nodes, and distinctive angled corner finials that create an architectural silhouette while maintaining a light, airy presence.

Its warm honey-colored finish has developed a rich patina over time, highlighting the convincing faux bamboo carving and giving the mirror an inviting character that complements both traditional and contemporary interiors. The clean geometry of the frame allows it to work beautifully in an entryway, powder room, bedroom, or layered into a gallery wall alongside artwork and other decorative objects.
