The finish has developed an attractive patina, with darker worn areas and small surface marks that add depth and character without taking away from the overall elegance of the piece.

This mirror has the relaxed charm associated with French turn-of-the-century faux bamboo furniture and accessories. Its proportions make it a versatile wall piece for an entryway, bedroom, powder room, dressing area, or above a small chest or console. The warm color works especially well with natural woods, painted furniture, wicker, rattan, and layered traditional interiors. It would also sit comfortably in a French country, English country house, coastal, or eclectic setting.
