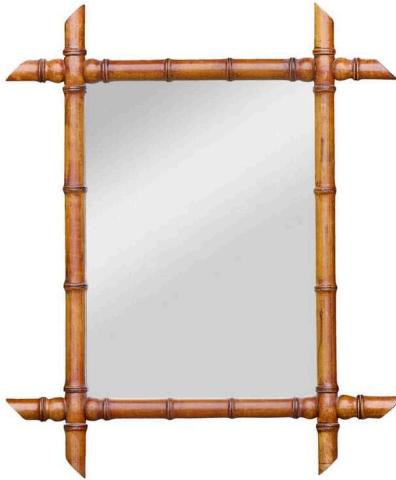

FRENCH FAUX BAMBOO WALL MIRROR WITH TURNED WOOD FRAME, CIRCA 1900

This French faux bamboo mirror from circa 1900 captures the enduring appeal of colonial and campaign-style design with its sculptural frame and warm, honeyed tone. Crafted from turned wood to imitate natural bamboo, the frame features stylized joints and sharply pointed corner caps that enhance its architectural silhouette. Each of the four ends projects slightly beyond the glass, adding depth and dimension without overwhelming the mirror's relatively modest proportions. The wood has developed a rich patina, with small age-related marks and speckling that reflect decades of use and care.

The mirror plate sits cleanly within the frame, reflecting with clarity while remaining understated enough to let the carved form take center stage. This piece is well-suited for a range of interiors—from English Colonial and country house to coastal or even tropical modern spaces. It could hang above a console or chest, in a powder room, or in a breezy hallway as a decorative accent.

The back features the original wood panel and updated wire for secure hanging. A handsome, character-filled mirror that blends classic French craftsmanship with exotic inspiration.
