A charming faux bamboo mirror in walnut, crafted in France around 1900. Its compact, vertical form and warm walnut patina make it an easy addition to both traditional and eclectic interiors. The mirror retains its original backboard, and the glass shows the gentle signs of age expected in a piece of this vintage, contributing to its authenticity and charm.

Ideal in a powder room, entryway, or as part of a layered salon-style wall, this decorative mirror offers a subtle nod to exoticism through the lens of French craftsmanship. A classic example of the faux bamboo trend popular across Europe at the turn of the century, appreciated today for its balance of rustic texture and tailored design.
