A French chandelier from the 19th century, crafted in hand-forged iron and richly detailed with strings of cut glass beads. The chandelier's structure is defined by its graceful, elongated silhouette, composed of six scrolling arms that rise from a tiered central column. Each arm is adorned with bands of faceted glass beads, catching and diffusing light with subtle sparkle while emphasizing the sculptural ironwork beneath. The combination of raw metal and delicate glass creates an elegant interplay of texture — both refined and slightly industrial — that reflects the craftsmanship of provincial French lighting from the period.

The six sockets rest atop small bobeche, each framed by geometric scrolls that echo the movement of the chandelier's curving arms. The original painted and silvered surface shows a beautifully aged patina, softening the iron's tone and adding depth to its timeworn finish.

Evoking both rustic restraint and refined ornament, this chandelier would suit interiors ranging from French country and neoclassical to more contemporary settings that embrace historical texture. Its balanced form and modest sparkle make it ideal for use in a dining room, entryway, or salon.
