The feet were tipped after the table's creation, probably a hundred years ago to increase its height. The sides present no décor and the back is bare, the table will look at its best placed against a wall. With its elegant Rococo lines, skillfully carved décor and natural patina, this French beech wood and marble top console table from the 18th century will bring a graceful presence to any home, perhaps showcased in a living room, bedroom or foyer.
