This antique French chandelier, crafted circa 1900, showcases the bold presence and lasting elegance of hand-forged wrought iron. Designed in a spherical or globe form, the chandelier is constructed from six shaped iron bands that curve gracefully to form a cage-like frame. Each of the six arms scrolls outward in classic symmetry and supports a candle-style socket, all of which have been professionally rewired for use in the United States. Decorative linking chains between the arms add a sense of cohesion and architectural rhythm, enhancing the fixture's sculptural form.

The iron surface retains a dark patinated finish that speaks to its age and handmade character, with subtle hammer marks and textural variation that reflect traditional blacksmith techniques. Its understated ornamentation and structural clarity allow it to complement a range of interiors—from French country homes to mountain lodges and transitional city spaces. Measuring 30 inches in diameter and 21 inches high (not including chain), this chandelier offers a striking focal point while maintaining a balanced and timeless profile.
