Original floral castings and flanged detailing on the stem and mount offer a subtle nod to the Art Deco aesthetic, without sacrificing the fixture's utilitarian core.

This piece has been professionally rewired for use in the United States, making it both functional and safe for modern interiors. With its generous proportions and open, airy form, this chandelier lends itself particularly well to larger dining rooms, kitchens, or entryways seeking a statement piece with authentic 20th-century character. Its matte iron finish adds depth and visual texture, allowing it to integrate effortlessly into both rustic and industrial-style interiors.
