## OIL ON BOARD PAINTING OF HORSE IN STABLE BY LOUIS NADLER, EARLY 20TH CENTURY

This early 20th-century oil on board by American artist Louis Nadler offers a vivid portrait of a chestnut horse standing alert in its stall. Characterized by its anatomical precision and warm, tonal palette, the composition captures a calm, almost meditative moment. The horse's deep reddish-brown coat gleams under the light filtering into the stable, its form sharply outlined against the pale stone walls and terracotta-tiled floor.

Typical of Nadler's equestrian work, the setting is rendered with realism and modest detail—a straw basket, scattered apples, a feed trough, and wooden framing evoke the quiet rhythm of stable life. The horse, subtly animated by the tilt of its head and the flick of its tail, remains the painting's anchor, offering a study in strength and poise. The piece is signed in the lower right and set within an ornate gilt frame with shell and foliate carving, enhancing its period charm.

An excellent piece for collectors of sporting or equestrian art, this painting balances formality with warmth and narrative restraint.
