This striking pair of 19th-century French architectural fragments has been transformed into table lamps, preserving the sculptural force of the original carved forms. Each lamp is composed of a substantial wooden element with a deeply hewn, spiral-like profile, giving the pair a bold, almost modern presence despite their antique origin. The hand-carved surfaces retain a strong sense of age and material, with visible variation in tone, old marks, and natural cracking that underscore their history.

Mounted vertically and rewired for the USA, the fragments now function as highly decorative lamps while still reading as genuine antique objects. Their compact footprint and strong silhouette make them especially effective on consoles, sideboards, or large side tables, where they can bring texture, height, and a distinctly collected look to an interior. The dark, weathered wood contrasts beautifully with both traditional and more minimal settings.

These are not polished decorative reproductions. They have real presence, real age, and the kind of irregularity that gives them character. As a pair, they offer strong visual symmetry while each retaining slight differences in carving and patina.
