This pair of English faux bamboo armchairs dates to the early 20th century, circa 1920, and reflects the enduring popularity of bamboo-inspired furniture in English interiors of the period. Crafted in wood and finished to simulate bamboo, the frames feature turned and knuckle-detailed elements throughout, creating a convincing and well-proportioned interpretation of the style.

Each chair has a gently arched crest rail above a decorative lattice back, with shaped arms and an open, architectural structure. The chairs rest on straight legs with stretchers, providing both stability and visual balance. The design is light and decorative while remaining practical and comfortable, making the pair well suited for use as occasional armchairs, bedroom seating, or in a sunroom or veranda setting.

The seats have been reupholstered in a neutral fabric that complements the dark faux bamboo finish without distracting from the form. These chairs work particularly well in English Country House, traditional, or eclectic interiors, and pair easily with both antique and contemporary furnishings.
