This pair of English mahogany hall chairs dates to the 19th century and stands out for its dramatic carved backrests featuring stylized eagle heads gripping carved rings in their beaks. Each chair features a shaped seat with a curved front rail and an incised outline that follows the frame's contours, adding depth and refinement. The front legs are subtly tapered and slightly splayed, while the back legs have a gentle rear saber curve, all resting solidly for use in an entryway, hallway, or as decorative side chairs. The rich polish of the mahogany enhances the natural grain and gives the pair a formal presence.
