PAIR OF ENGLISH VICTORIAN OAK STOOLS WITH LINEN UPHOLSTERY, CIRCA 1880

A handsome pair of English oak stools dating to circa 1880, combining the warmth of richly toned wood with the simplicity of newly upholstered seats. Each stool is raised on four slender turned oak legs, detailed with groups of incised rings and small rounded turnings near the feet. The restrained decoration gives the pair a light, almost architectural quality while retaining the craftsmanship and solidity associated with late 19th-century English furniture.

The square seats have been newly upholstered in a neutral linen fabric, finished with individually applied nailhead trim. The natural texture and understated color of the upholstery complement the warm patina of the oak and make these stools particularly versatile in both traditional and more contemporary interiors.

Useful as occasional seating, the pair would work equally well at the foot of a bed, beneath a console table, in a dressing room, or separated as small accent stools within a living room. Their compact scale and clean silhouette make them easy pieces to place, while the turned legs and mellow oak lend just enough period character.
