This charming pair of French stools dates to the 1920s and reflects the refined elegance of the Louis XVI style. Each stool features fluted, tapering legs joined by an X-form stretcher, enhancing stability while adding visual interest. The carved rosettes at the knees and the *rais-de-cœur* detail just beneath the apron exemplify classical neoclassical ornamentation. Finished in a warm, creamy tone with gilt accents that highlight the carving, the painted surface shows subtle, desirable wear consistent with age.

The square seats are newly upholstered in a neutral woven linen fabric, offering a clean contrast to the patinated wood. Compact yet stately, these stools measure approximately 13 inches square by 19 inches high—ideal as accents in a dressing room, flanking a fireplace, or adding symmetry beside a console or bed. Their versatility and scale make them equally functional as spare seating or decorative supports for books or trays.

A lovely example of early 20th-century French craftsmanship, retaining the charm and clarity of classical proportions with timeless appeal.
