Crafted in England in the early 19th century, this Regency Pembroke table presents a refined balance of form and function. Constructed from mahogany with a warm, lustrous patina, the table features a rectangular top with rounded drop leaves, allowing it to expand from a compact console to a more generous surface when needed. The perimeter is inlaid with a light satinwood banding, accentuating the rich tone of the mahogany and underscoring the table's neoclassical influences.

The single frieze drawer is fitted with brass oval pulls and framed by delicate inlay work. The piece stands on tapered legs terminating in original brass casters, which allow the table to glide easily across a room—a practical detail characteristic of the Regency period. The overall design reflects the Regency period's emphasis on proportion, grace, and practicality, while the quality of the mahogany and craftsmanship speaks to its upper-tier origin.

With the leaves down, the table maintains a compact footprint (20.5" wide), and when opened extends to 38", making it ideal for both small spaces and formal interiors. A timeless piece that bridges decorative appeal and usability.

Whether used as a writing table, side table, or occasional dining surface, this Pembroke table exemplifies the restrained elegance and practicality of early 19th-century English design. A versatile addition to both traditional and transitional interiors.
