A charming oil on canvas portrait of a Boston Terrier, signed lower right P. A. Schwartz and dating to circa 1900. The dog is shown standing in profile with its head turned toward the viewer, creating a lively and direct sense of presence. Its brindle-and-white coat, upright ears, compact build, short muzzle, and distinctive white facial blaze are characteristic of the Boston Terrier, a breed that became especially popular in the United States and abroad at the turn of the 20th century.

The artist captures the dog with warmth and personality, giving particular attention to the alert expression, rounded eyes, white paws, and brass-studded collar. The pale background and lightly suggested landscape keep the composition open and decorative, while the restrained palette of warm browns, creams, and soft greens gives the painting an easy, understated charm.

The handling is detailed enough to describe the animal clearly, but still painterly, especially in the coat, ground, and distant landscape.

The painting is presented in a simple giltwood frame with a rounded profile, appropriate to the period and subject. A delightful antique dog portrait, well suited for a library, study, gallery wall, traditional interior, or collector of canine and animal paintings.
