The lantern's geometric lines and honest materiality make it equally suited to traditional, rustic, or transitional interiors, while the transparency of the glass allows it to illuminate evenly without visual heaviness. It has been recently rewired for use in the United States. Measuring just over 42 inches in height, this piece offers a strong vertical presence without overwhelming a space. Its combination of clean form, old-world craftsmanship, and practical scale makes it a highly adaptable lighting feature with timeless appeal.
